- Proposals should be submitted in English to mrc@unwe.bg no later than **August, 15th 2022** **August 29th 2022** *with full text of the papers.*
- Blind review will be performed and authors will be informed by **7th of September** about the approval of their papers or will receive notes and guidance.
- Registration form should be submitted by **September 10th 2022** at <http://conference.mrccenter.info/>.
- The proposal identification and the complete paper must be attached as a MS Word document.
- The proposal identification should be between 300 and 500 words.
- The complete paper must be no more than 20 pages.
- Papers will be published in a special issue on the website of the MRC and submitted for indexing at Web of Science.
